## **ACT Test**

If you want to take the ACT at Richmond High School on December 9<sup>th</sup> and you miss the November 3<sup>rd</sup> deadline, you can still register by November 17<sup>th</sup> and pay a late fee.

Remember to bring a photo ID, your admission ticket, an approved calculator, and sharpened #2 pencils with you on the day of the test. You can register and set up an online account at <a href="https://www.act.org">www.act.org</a>, or if you have already taken the ACT, you can re-register online.

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Driver's License (if any)
- 2016 W-2 Forms and records of \$ earned
- 2016 Federal Income Tax Returns
- 2016 Untaxed Income Records
- Any current bank statements
- Any current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bonds, and other investment records.
