HAVE YOU TAKEN THE ACT YET?

Register by *September 16th*, and you can take the ACT test on **October 22nd**.

Register by *November 4th*, and you can take the test on **December 10th**.

You can register online at www.actstudent.org.

If you are planning to go to college and have not taken the ACT, you need to consider taking it at the next available test date! See your counselor if you have questions or if you need help registering. Fee waivers are available for students who qualify.
